General Event Information

ELIGIBILITY

Randolph County Senior Games and/or SilverArts is open to all North Carolina Residents age 50 and older. Participants must reside in North Carolina at least 3 consecutive months out of the year. Non-residents of Randolph County may participate upon approval from the Coordinator. Your age on December 31, 2017 will determine the category that you will compete in. Men and Women compete in separate categories in the following age groups: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+.

REGISTRATION

To register for the Randolph County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts, complete the entry form and submit payment to RCSG, no later than **Friday, February 24, 2017**. Each individual, including both doubles partners and all team members, must submit a completed entry form with total payment to **RCSG by February 24th. There are no exceptions!** *The deadline is strictly enforced in fairness to all participants*. Entry forms received after February 24th will be returned.

CONFIRMATION

FEES

To participate in the Randolph County Senior Games and/or the SilverArts, there is either a **\$10.00 Early Bird Entry Fee** (if registered by February 17th) or a **\$12.00 Regular Entry Fee** (if registered between February 18 - February 24). A facility fee will be charged for those who wish to participate in the following activities: Awards Banquet (**\$5.00**), Billiards (**\$3.00**), Bowling (**\$6.75 per event**), Cycling (**\$10.00 per cyclist**), Golf (**\$10.00**), Miniature Golf (**\$3.00**) and the 5K Run (**\$20.00**). These facility fees are in addition to the entry fee. The Awards Banquet and Golf fee will be paid with your entry fee. The facility fee for Billiards, Bowling, Cycling, Miniature Golf and the 5K Run must be paid directly to the facility for 2017. Your entry fee includes the following: a RCSG T-Shirt, participant number, meal cost at the Awards Banquet and admission to the Opening Ceremony, Performing Arts Follies and the SilverArts Showcase.

REPORTING TIMES

All participants should report to their events at least 15 minutes early to pick up registration information. Your participant number will be given out at your first event. For outdoor events, it is recommended to bring a chair.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN IN AND SHOW A PHOTO ID AT EACH EVENT.

For each **NEW PARTICIPANT** (someone who has never participated in the Randolph County Senior Games) that you bring into Senior Games, your name will be entered into a drawing. The drawing will be held at the Awards Dinner. The winner of the drawing will receive a prize worth \$25.00.

QUALIFYING FOR STATE FINALS

The 2017 North Carolina Senior Games State Finals will be held in Raleigh on September 18 - September 24, 2017. The State Softball Tournament is TBD, the Bocce and Cornhole Tournaments are October 3 - 4 in Clayton, the Golf Tournament is August 30 - 31 in Clemmons, the Pickleball Tournament is October 17 - 20 1 in Concord and the Basketball Tournament is August 30 - 31 in Greenville. To qualify, a participant must place 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any official sports event offered at the Randolph County Senior Games. <u>EXCEPTION: Golfers must meet the Minimum</u> <u>Performance Scores (MPS) & finish in the top 3 in their age group to qualify for State Finals. MPS is abailable from Cindy Castle and in the NCSG Rules Book on the NCSG website (www.ncseniorgames.org) In SilverArts, ONLY the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place finishers in Heritage & Visual Arts, the 1st & 2nd place finishers in Literary Arts, the 1st place finisher in Cheerleading and the "Best of Show" winner in Performing Arts will qualify for State Finals competition. If for any reason the act that wins "Best of Show" can not participate at State Finals and notifies RCSG by May 5th, the act that finishes as the first runner-up will have the opportunity to advance to State Finals.</u>

General Event Information (continued)

SILVERARTS

All prospective SilverArts participants must complete the enclosed RCSG entry form. All entry forms must be turned in by **Friday, February 24, 2017**. Art work should be brought to the Sunset Theatre located at 234 Sunset Avenue in Asheboro on Monday, March 13 from 9:00am - 2:00pm. At that time, you will need to fill out an information form for each entry. If you have any questions about SilverArts that is not covered here in after, please call Cindy Castle, Senior Games Coordinator at 626-1240 x 5.

- I. **ELIGIBILITY:** Entries must be the original work of the artist and must be a work created after the artist is of age 50. Artwork must have been completed in the last two years.
- II. Each artist may enter up to three (3) pieces in any combination of categories. However, only one (1) piece per sub-category will be accepted. If the total number of entries exceeds the available display space, only one or two pieces per person will be displayed. The SilverArts Coordinator reserves the right to choose which pieces will be displayed if the total number of entries exceeds the available display space.
- III. SilverArts is not a sale. However, if you would like to offer your work for sale, please let the Senior Games Coordinator know. Artwork may not be removed by buyers until after the display is finished.
- IV. Artists may not enter art work if the art piece or literary work has previously been entered in a SilverArts Showcase.
- V. RCSG reserves the right to refuse or remove any or all art pieces that are deemed obnoxious or repulsive in character.
- VI. Some Visual Arts Entries may be chosen to be displayed at the Randolph Arts Guild.
- VII. The **'Specific Category Requirements For SilverArts''** located on the insert are subject to change without notice.

AWARDS

Games

Any participant who finishes first, second, or third in any age category for any event during the games will receive one gold, silver, and/or bronze medal to represent all medals won by that participant. Participants will also receive a keepsake results sheet suitable for framing to commemorate each first, second, or third place finish. Certificates will be given to those completing the "SilverStriders Fun Walk".

SilverArts

- Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place winners in each sub-category. Any participate who
 finishes 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place in any sub-category will receive one gold, silver, or bronze medal to represent
 all medals won. Winners will be viewable at the SilverArts Showcase on Tuesday, March 14th from 3:30 pm
 until 5:30 pm at the Sunset Theatre.
- A "Peoples Choice Award" will be given this year to an entry in either the Heritage, Literary or Visual Arts. The "Peoples Choice Award" will be voted on by the visitors to the SilverArts Showcase. The artist of the entry that receives the most votes will receive a Certificate and a \$25.00 gift card. The "Peoples Choice Award" is not eligible for State Finals Competition unless it also received 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in a Heritage or Visual Arts sub-category or 1st or 2nd in the Literary Arts.
- A "Best of Show" Award will be given to the best overall Performing Arts Act at the SilverArts Follies. The judges will award the overall "Best of Show" and the winner will receive a Certificate and a \$25.00 gift card. The act selected "Best of Show" will also have the opportunity to represent the Randolph County Senior Games at State Finals.

APPENDIX T SPECIFIC CATEGORY REQUIREMENTS FOR SILVERARTS

- All persons entering SilverArts must be 50 years of age or better as of December 31st, a N.C. resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the calendar year, and must qualify through a Local Senior Games SilverArts program for State Finals.
- Art entry/entries incorrectly categorized by the artist, or not in compliance with NCSG Guidelines and Requirements, will not be considered in the judging process.
- See SilverArts Guidelines for general requirements.

A. Heritage Arts

- Entries must be the work of the individual and not a group.
- Heritage Art entries must be an original work. Patterns may be used, but no stamped pieces will be accepted.
- Pottery must be hand built or thrown.
- Ceramic molds will not be accepted.
- All framed entries must be securely wired, ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Two-dimensional work not properly framed and wired will not be displayed.
- Framed entries can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- All entries, except framed work, must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3'(L) x 5'(Height).
- Groupings (sets) shall have no more than 3 separate pieces per set. All objects within each piece of the set must be contained within or attached to one of the 3 pieces of the set.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artist must send a photo of entry <u>with</u> State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned.
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- The heritage arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

B. Visual Arts

- All artwork, except sculpture, must be framed (or gallery wrapped), securely wired, and ready to be hung (no serrated hooks or string). Artwork, except sculpture, not properly wired will not be displayed.
- Artwork, except sculpture, can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame.
- Entries can be no heavier than 50 pounds.
- Sculpture groupings (sets) may have no more than 3 pieces per grouping (set).
- Mixed media may be a freestanding piece.
- Freestanding entries must be able to be displayed in an area 3'(W) x 3' (L) x 5' (height).
- Artists, or their representatives, are responsible to deliver and pick-up their entry at/during the designated times.
- If on-site assembly is required, details must be specified on the Information Form for NCSG <u>prior</u> approval.
- The art piece must be an original work, not a print.
- Artist's name and title of entry must appear on, or be attached to, entry for identification.
- Artist must send a photograph of entry <u>with</u> State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. Photos cannot be returned.
- The visual arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.

C. Literary Arts

- All entries must be typed, double-spaced, on 8-1/2 x 11 paper and have a minimum of 1" margins. A minimum font size is 10-pt type (preferably "times new roman or arial").
- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories, essays, and life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages.
- All entries must have a title page, which includes title of entry, sub-category, and name of artist.
- Artist's name must not appear on the content pages.
- A display-quality copy of the winning Literary Arts entries, and two (2) additional copies, should be submitted to NCSG by the artist with their official State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. No framed or matted entries will be accepted.
- The original and all copies will be retained by NCSG.
- The literary arts entry entered at State Finals must be the same entry that won at the Local Games.
- An artist may only submit one (1) entry per sub-category at State Finals.
- D. Performing Arts
- An artist may only have one (1) entry per size of act in each subcategory.
- Performing entries are limited to three (3) minutes of <u>on-stage</u> time. Exceeding the time limit will result in automatic disqualification. Timing is the performer's responsibility and begins with the first note of music or the first movement visible to the audience and ends with the final note of music or movement of the act.
- Performing entries may be one of the following: (a) soloists, (b) small groups (2 4 performers), or (c) large groups (5 or more performers). Accompanist(s) <u>will</u> be counted to determine size of act. No one under age 50 as of Dec. 31st will be permitted on stage and an accompanist must be a registered participant.
- All performers for all acts must enter stage right and exit stage left or begin and end on the stage. See the SilverArts Manual for a stage diagram.
- If recorded music is used, it must be an mp3 file (submitted electronically or on a flash drive) or a high-quality CD. Music must be sent with the State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form. No recorded instruction is permitted. This should be the only track on the CD/flashdrive or electronic file. Music may be picked up following the performance. It cannot be mailed/returned.
- At State Finals, NCSG can provide the following items: chairs, microphone(s), piano and sound system. The act is responsible for all other props and equipment and <u>must</u> get NCSG <u>advance</u> approval for use at Show. Props must be small, few, light-weight and easy to set up quickly.
- Voice presentations must be a live performance by the artist. Background music can be recorded. Lip-synch is not permitted as a performing art.
- The Group Leader, who must be a participant, must complete the SilverArts Information Form for the group and submit it with their State Finals Entry Form and each member of the group must submit their own personal State Finals Entry Form by the August 1st deadline.
- The performance at State Finals <u>must be the same performance</u> that won at the Local Games; i.e. same song, dance, music, etc.
- No live animals are allowed, except for service animals.
